- Are thinking of giving their home a major makeover

This home expert information event forms part of Ulster Bank's ongoing 'Do Good, Feel Good' initiative, which encourages colleagues to come together and raise money for a registered charity or charities of their choice.

In June, thousand of colleagues came together and raised over €100,000 for charities around the country through a range of bank-organised challenge events, from walks and runs to bake sales and bucket collections.
